

## LANDSCAPE

At the current stage, viewpoint photography has been undertaken from various positions around the site, the positions of the viewpoints and corresponding photography can be seen here. This gives an impression of the current site appearance from varying distances. The photography was taken during winter months as to give an idea of a 'worst case scenario' of visibility i.e. without foliage to act as screening.

The viewpoint photography has allowed for photomontages to represent how the proposed solar farm would look as part of the landscape; these can be viewed below.



## Public Right of Way

There is a poorly maintained footpath which runs through the middle of the site; this can be seen on the site constraints map on Board 6. Site visits indicated that this footpath is in poor condition where it crosses the stream in the middle of the site.

JBM will widen, improve and enhance this footpath, with wildflowers planted along the whole footpath route, new tree and hedge planting on either side, educational board and benches installed around the path, in a considerable effort to create a fantastic community asset.
