ECOLOGY AND BIODIVERSITY NET GAIN

A preliminary Ecological Appraisal has been completed by a team of expert ecologists. The PEA assessed the potential of the site to support both species of conservation concern and other species who may use the site.

The proposed solar farm has been designed to preserve and protect all existing habitats and features of ecological importance, including woodland, hedgerows, streams and ditches. The change of use from intensive agriculture to grazing land will improve the overall quality of habitats on site over time. Safeguarding these habitats will be achieved through good practice mitigation measures during the construction phase as well the achievement of Biodiversity Net Gain

JBM will go beyond the standard net gain of 10% in an effort to significantly enhance the biodiversity value of the site. Through a number of innovative methods, the site will achieve a biodiversity net gain in excess of 30%.
